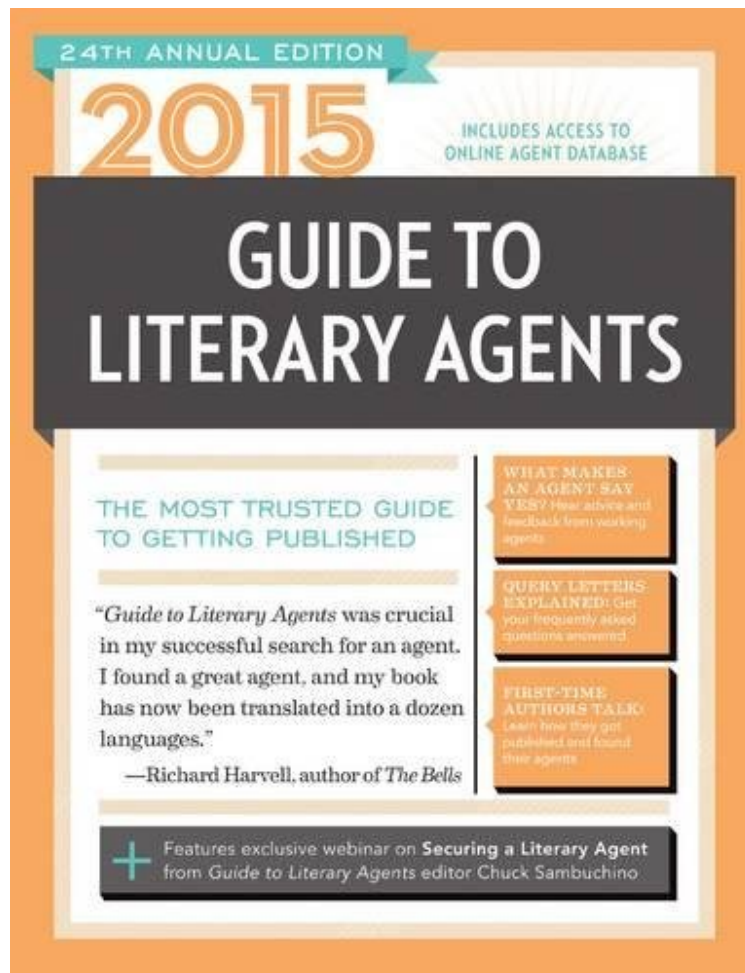

Fortunately, there is a cross reference index, which lists agents/agencies by what type of works they will consider. Also, the book includes a coding system that helps the reader know if the firm/agent is accepting new clients. As a bonus, several articles at the beginning give tips on submission and other useful information, including testimonials from successful authors about their experiences, one of whom self-published his work initially, only to be contacted by a publisher later based on his success.
